Information and Guidelines

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

Unless there are tee times available, there will be no additional tee times added to any of the leagues. Leagues which drop below the minimum required golfers will be dismissed from the program.

1. Leagues are required to have a minimum of 12 golfers (3 tee times). Each league is contracted for a specific number of tee times and will be expected to provide enough players to fill those tee times. It is the responsibility of the league representative to let the host course pro/manager know if the league will not need all of their allotted times each week. Tee times can be adjusted up or down based on demand. **League fees are only applicable on your scheduled day.**
2. **Please Note:** League play is available from the first Monday in April that the course is open through the last Friday of **October**.
3. **THE JOLIET PARK DISTRICT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CANCEL LEAGUE PLAY FOR DISTRICT AUTHORIZED SPECIAL EVENTS. LEAGUES WILL BE NOTIFIED AT LEAST TWO WEEKS IN ADVANCE OF SPECIAL EVENTS.**
4. **THE JOLIET PARK DISTRICT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO RESTRICT LEAGUE PLAY AND MAKE ASSIGNMENTS FOR LEAGUE PLAY IN A MANNER WHICH LEAST SIGNIFICANTLY IMPACTS THE OPPORTUNITY FOR OPEN GOLF.**
5. There will be a mandatory league meeting with golf course management before league play begins to discuss rules and regulations. League tee times will not be secured until a meeting has taken place.

FEES:

1. Leagues are required to submit individual registration fees of **\$10.00** per person per league. A complete list of league players, their address and telephone numbers and their individual registration fees are due upon completion and submission of application.
2. League green fees and cart fees are in accordance with the Joliet Park District Golf Daily Fee schedule for 9 or 18 holes at the current Resident, Partner Resident, or Non-resident league rate. Golf Memberships will be honored for leagues. Resident Discount Cards are required by the Joliet Park District for those golfers who desire to pay the discounted resident daily fee. All players are required to check in with the cashier, obtain a receipt and present it.

APPLICATION CRITERIA:

1. An official application form with payment must be submitted to the golf course by March 1, 2026.
2. Existing leagues may select the same day/time, same course only. The morning leagues are restricted to begin no earlier than 8:00 a.m. on the same day and course.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

1. One person shall be designated as league representative and be the liaison between the league and the Park District. Should any league member not be able to play on the designated league day and time, the league representative must make arrangements with the course pro/manager to reschedule these rounds.
2. League members are subject to follow course rules at all times.
3. League members desiring to play more than 9 holes must have an 18-hole greens fee ticket and an 18-hole cart fee if a cart is utilized.
4. Every attempt will be made to start leagues on time. Any league players who arrive late will be permitted to tee off on a first-come, first-serve basis and are subject to play with non-league golfers.
5. Cancellations within a league are subject to fill in by non-league players at the discretion of the Clubhouse Manager or Starter.
6. League rates are available. Please have all league players identify themselves when paying.
7. Absolutely no outside food or beverages allowed.


